If to begin with your child finds this challenging use a 100 square. Remind them more is gorward (the number gets bigger) and less is backwards (the number gets smaller).

- Continue to count to 100.
- Say a number- one more/ one less
- Use in everyday activities. For example I have 32 books and one more is 33.
- Look and talk about the 100 square.
