the cat said, 'meooooow!' and the dog said, 'Grrrrrrr!'

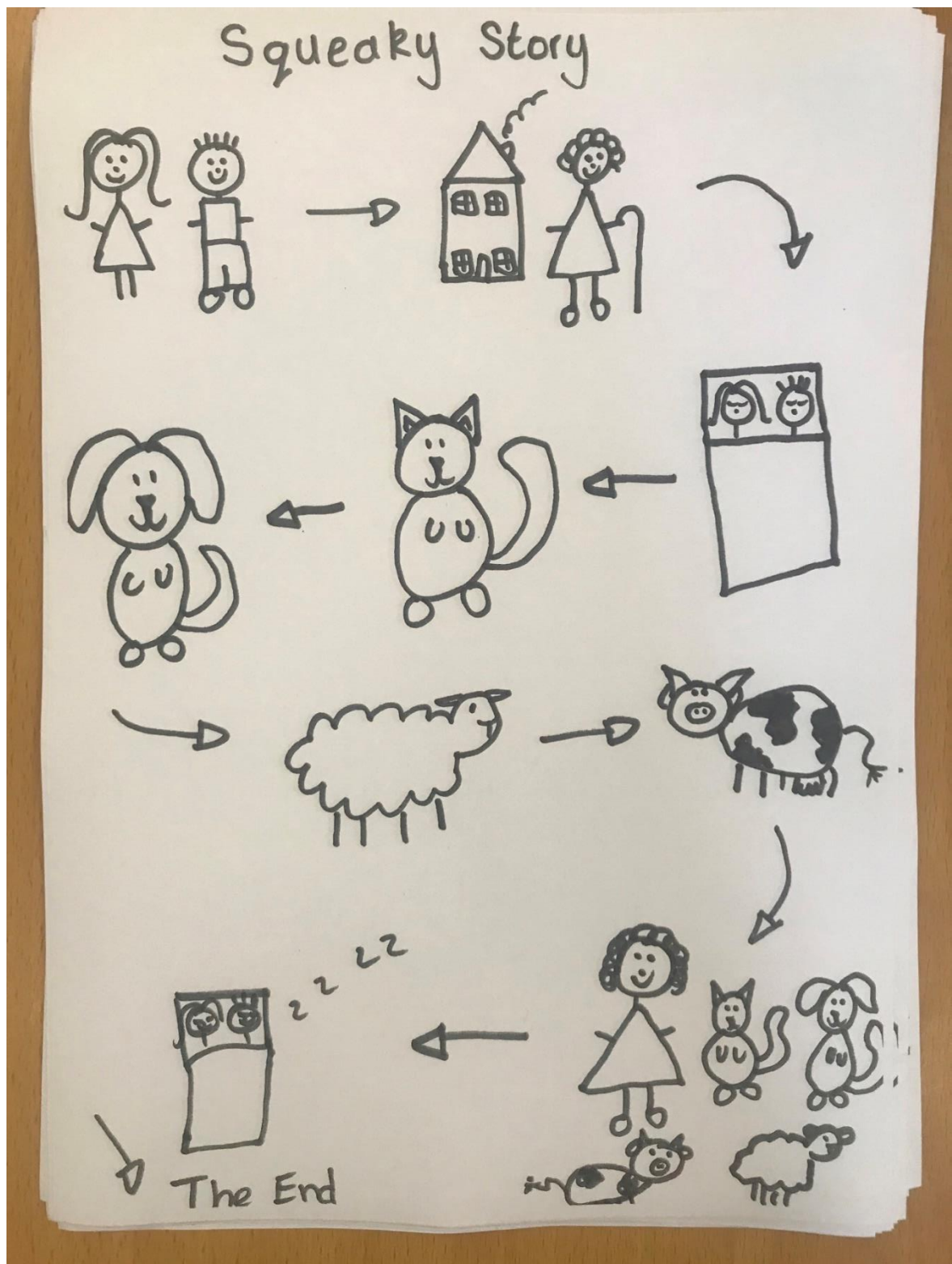
keep adding in animals –sheep, cow, horse, donkey, etc. till:

Beginning

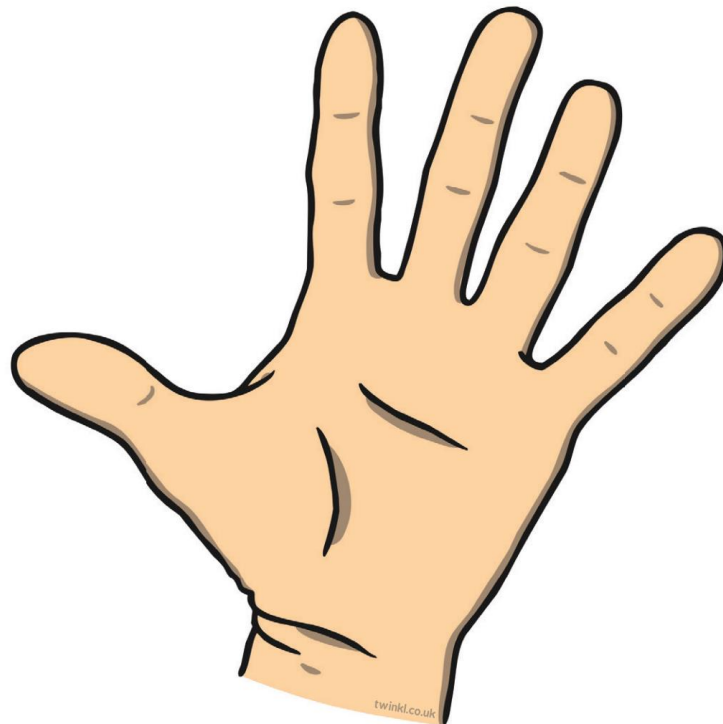
- Opening- Three characters happily playing (Looking for some green grass)

Middle

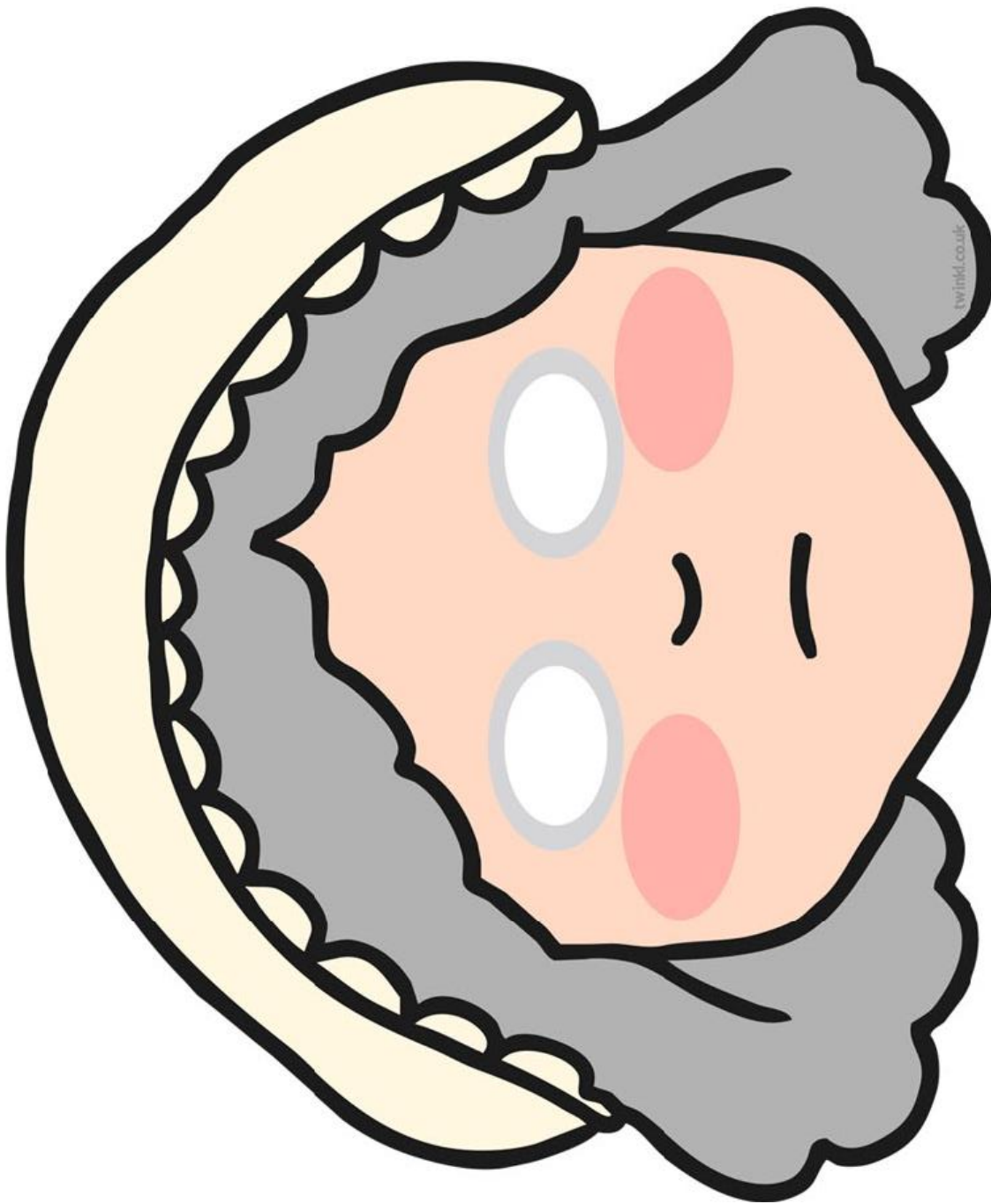
- Problem - Troll under the bridge- Wants to eat them

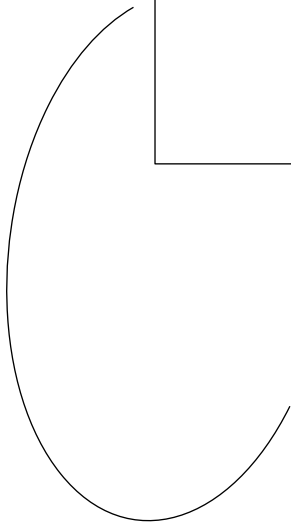
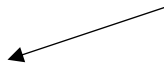
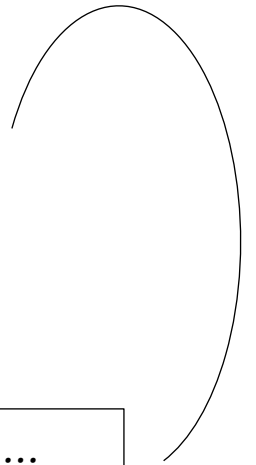
