


So, Grandma said, OK – and she – Took away The cat – meow! The dog – grrrr! Etc

Then, she said, 'Goodnight', gave them a kiss, turned out the light, closed the door..... and the children fell fast asleep. Shhhhhhhh!





Beginning


- Opening- Three characters happily playing (Looking for some green grass)
- Build up-something horrible comes along (Troll)


Middle


- Problem - Troll under the bridge- Wants to eat them
