Drop off your child at 8:45am (please be on time)






Collect your child at 3pm (please be on time)



Packed lunches must be healthy.






At the moment, home dinners are not permitted.



Children **are not** permitted to wear PPE in school, including a face mask.


If your child wears a mask to/from school, you must remove it before they enter
