- Jump and count.

- Use everyday opportunities to count.
- Miss a number out when counting, to see if your child notices.

Activity Ideas:

- Point to each number card and say the number.
- Order the number cards.
- What can you do before I count to 10? For example build a tower. Swap roles.
- Count objects in the house or at the park. For example count leaves/cars.
- Write numbers to 10

Spring 1

Name the days of the week

Key Vocabulary:

Monday
Tuesday
Wednesday
Thursday
Friday
Saturday
Sunday
Tomorrow
Yesterday
Today

Top Tips:

- Talk about what day it is everyday.
- Ask questions- what happens on a Saturday?
- Ask questions- If its Monday today what day is it tomorrow?

Activity Ideas:

- Order the days of the week, with support.
- Make up your own songs, including all days of the week.
- Encourage your children to use the days of the week. For example tomorrow we're going to the park. On Tuesday we're going to the park.

Count in 10s to 100

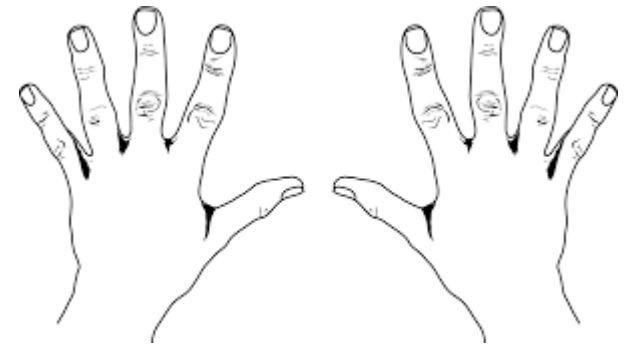

Activity Ideas:

- Count in 10s - can you count forwards and backwards?
- Count in 10s - count in different voices (whisper, pirate).
- Use yours and your families hands/ feet to count in 10s
- Teach somebody new to count in 10s.

Top Tips:

- Use everyday opportunities to count.
- Miss a number out when counting, to see if your child notices.

Activity Ideas:

- Point to each number card and say the number.
- Order the number cards.
- What can you do before I count to 20? For example tie shoe laces. Swap roles.
- Count to 20 after brushing their teeth/ driving in the car/ walking to school.
- Count fingers and toes.

Summer 2

One more/ one less to 20

Key Vocabulary:

Numbers to 20
More

Bigger

Top Tips:

- If to begin with your child finds this challenging use a number line.

Remind them more is forward (the number gets bigger) and less is backwards (the number gets smaller).

Activity Ideas:

- Continue to count to 20.
- Say a number- one more/ one less
- Use in everyday activities. For example I have apples and one more is 6.
