

HOME LEARNING SUPPORT (in the event of a school closure)

Dear Parent / Carer.

As I am sure you are aware from the media, the whole country at present is rising to the challenge of the outbreak of the coronavirus. This is an evolving situation and we are working closely with DDAT, our academy trust, in a proactive way based on the information coming from the government through Public Health England and the Department for Education.

At this current time, our school remains open and our normal attendance procedures are expected, unless the Department for Education and public Health England advise us otherwise.

However, we are aware that the management of this outbreak is a dynamic situation and we have therefore outlined plans as part of our risk assessment procedures in the event of having to close our school. To ensure that your child does not miss out on valuable learning time in the event of a school closure, we have put together a 'home learning' pack.

We wanted to send out these resources in advance so that we can ensure that we have everything in place to support your child's learning, in the event that we have to close our school. Please can I ask you to familiarise yourself with the home learning pack. If you have any questions about the resources, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.

We have included some additional resources to support key skills, for example spellings and times tables.
