I will try my best to:

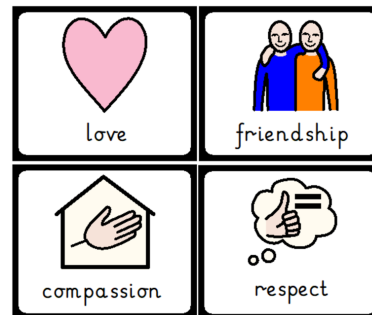
- ◆ Come to nursery every day and on time

At St Chad's, we believe that strong partnerships between home and nursery are the foundation of every child's success.

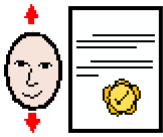

On behalf of the whole St Chad's community, thank you for your continued support.





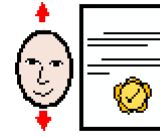
NURSERY AGREEMENT:

As a school, we will:

- ◆ Provide your child with a safe, happy and nurturing environment, rooted in our Christian vision: *Love God, Love Neighbour, Love Self*
- ◆ Promote our core Christian values of **love, friendship, compassion and respect** in all that we do
- ◆ Get to know your child as a unique individual, nurturing their interests, strengths and needs
- ◆ Support your child to begin to understand and follow our nursery rules: **Safe, Ready, Love**, so they can thrive in a calm and respectful space
- ◆ Help your child to live out our school's LOVE Promise in a way that is meaningful to them
- ◆ Encourage healthy habits through activities such as healthy snack time, physical play and learning about self-care
- ◆ Foster an understanding and respect for all faiths and cultures within our Christian ethos
- ◆ Deliver a carefully planned, play-based curriculum that meets the EYFS statutory requirements and supports your child's holistic development
