- > Book a test as soon as possible














> There are 3 ways to obtain a test:

- ➤ The whole household must isolate while waiting for the test result
- > Siblings in school must remain at home








- > You do not need to call the GP or 111
- **➢ Book a test online or call 119**







My child has tested negative for COVID....









➤ Your child can return - provided they do not have a high temperature and nobody at home is displaying symptoms

My child has tested positive for COVID....







- > Your child must not attend school contact school
- ➤ Your child must isolate for 10 days from first day of symptom(s) or from day of test if no symptoms
- ➤ Whole household must isolate for 10 days from first day of symptoms or from day of test if no symptoms
- ➤ Your child can return after 10 days of isolation provided they do not have a temperature and nobody at home is displaying symptoms

Someone in my household is showing symptoms of COVID....









- > Your child must not attend school contact school
- > Household member with symptoms must get a test
- Whole household isolates whilst waiting for the test result
- ➤ If the test result is negative and nobody else has symptoms, your child can come back to school

Absence due to COVID....





- Regular school attendance is vital. It is so important that children are attending school as much as possible after a very disruptive year.
- If your child is not in school, they are missing valuable learning.
- ➤ If your child cannot attend school due to COVID, he/she will be supported with remote learning.

Our priority is to ensure that every child achieves their very best....





- > Having a test is not nice but it is important
- ➤ After a very disruptive year, our priority is to ensure that our children are now in school as regularly as possible
- Please support us by following current government guidance

Some myth busters....



- ➤ We are not and cannot test children in school this is for secondary schools only
- >Only staff are being tested (twice weekly at home)
- ➤ After 10 days from testing positive for Covid, a cough and loss of taste/smell may continue. Your child can return to school as long as they have been fever-free for 48 hours
- ➤ If you hear about something and are not sure, talk to us
- ➤ If you have any worries/fears, talk to us




