Transition Week is an incredibly important event in school. We recognise that for many of our children, 'moving up' year groups can cause some worries. During transition week, our children have the opportunity to meet their new teacher, settle into their new classroom and make lots of new friends. During the week we also welcome our new Nursery and Reception children, who come into school for a series of stay and play sessions. Our Year 2 children also have the opportunity to visit their new schools (those transitioning to Hardwick spend the full week there)

After transition week, we also host and celebrate our Year 2 Leavers: this is a monumental event for our whole school community.

At present, organising these important events in our 'normal manner' is sadly not possible. Over the past month, I have had a number of parents message and call expressing their concerns at not having these events take place. As local cluster schools, we have also been sharing the same concerns. Both of these events are normally incredibly important, however, in light of the current situation that we find ourselves in, we believe that they are even more vital.

Due to COVID and the strict safety measures that we have in place, we are not in a position to host these events with the current 'bubble structure' and school opening plans that we have in place. Therefore, we are making the following date changes over the next few weeks in order for us to accommodate the events:
