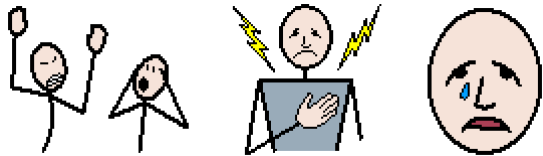


What is bullying?

A bully is someone who hurts another person more than once.

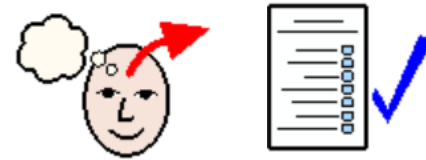


A bully uses behaviour to scare, hurt or upset another person.



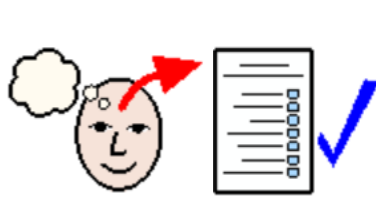
At our school, we use the word 'STOP' to spot bullying:

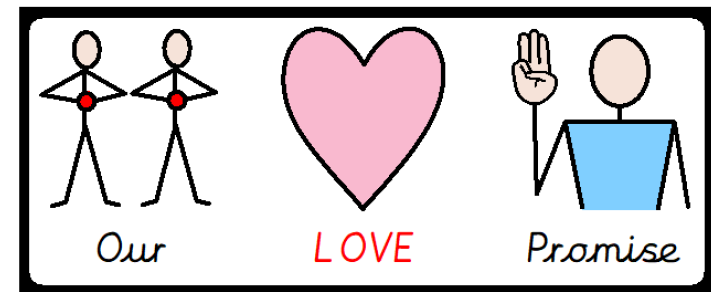


You can tell:

DON'T:

- Ignore the bullying
- Don't join in
- Stay silent

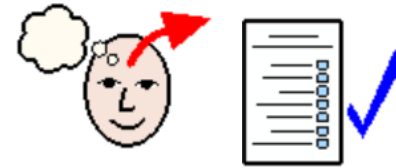


DO:

- Tell someone straight away

If you are being bullied....

DON'T:

- Do what they say
- Get angry or look upset
- Hit them
- Think it's your fault



DO:

- Ask them to **STOP** if you can
- Use eye contact and tell them to go away
- Ignore them
- Walk away
- **TELL SOMEONE**
