On behalf of our whole school community, thank you for your ongoing support.






## Things to Remember:

Please say good-bye to your child at the front of the line, before the school gate. A staff member will be there to greet your child. Parents **are not** permitted to enter through the main gate.

At the moment, home dinners are not permitted.




Children are not permitted to bring in anything from home e.g. toys.






## Things to Remember:


Attend school every day and on time:







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If your child or anyone in your household develops COVID symptoms, remain at home. Telephone school and book in a test.



**WASH YOUR HANDS**

Hand washing is a quick and simple way to protect you from germs. It's easy and only takes 20 seconds. Sing these words to the melody of "Twinkle Twinkle" while washing your hands!

- 1 Palm to palm**  
Twinkle Twinkle little star
- 2 Between Fingers**  
See how clean my two hands are
- 3 Back of Hands**  
Soap and water wash and scrub
- 4 Finger-tails**  
Get those germs off rub a dub
- 5 Base of thumb**  
Twinkle Twinkle little star
- 6 Wrists**  
See how clean my two hands are

Children **are not** permitted to wear PPE in school, including a face mask.

If your child wears a mask to/from school, you must remove it before they enter the gate, put it in a bag and take it home.
